WHEREAS it has been the desire of the above said authors of the trust and many benefactors from the public to form a public Charitable trust for the purpose of pr moting education and literacy levels among the public, to run old age homes and orphanages, to open centres for promoting self-employment to engage in charitable add human welfare activities by conducting pro-rams and actively participating in the same, to promote reli ious harmony and spirit of national integration among the youth and to indulge in other social welfare scrivities and have now decided to create such a trust with such a purpose, and

WHEREAS the three authors above said have each contributed Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one th usand only) to the Trust, constituting the 'Trust Fund' and

WHEREAS the aut ors of the Trust have declared and con stituted themselves into a charitable trust with option to increase the number of trustees, and

WHEREAS the trustees are willing to be invested with the ownership of the trust Fund, covered by the sche ule hereto annexed, for the purpose of carrying out the object of the trust in accordance with the directions of the Boar of Trustees of the Trust as set forth hereunder.

Now it is her bydeclared by the rustees of the Trust as follows:

### ARTICLE 1.

(a) That they have created a public charitable trust to be known

(b) That the sum of Rs 3,000/- (Three thousand only) already contributed to the Trust by the authors and accepted by them as the Board of Trustees and all sums of money, lands and other property that may hereafter be collected or received by way of onetions, bequest- or otherwise for the purpose of the trust and all incomes, profits or gains arising to the Trust and all income arising therefrom and accretions therato (all of which are included in the expression 'Trust Pund and properties') shall be held in trust and applied for the purpose as set forth below, in accordance with the provisions and directions herein contained.

#### ARTICLE 2 - NAME.

The name of the Trust shall be NATIONAL EDUCATIONAL SOCIAL TRUST and the present office is at Trip nithura, Ernakulam istrict.


ARTICLE 3 - TRUSTIES OF MEMBERS OF THE TRUST AND WHEIR CA EGORIES.

All the authors of the National Educational Social Trust, all persons who contribute speci ied amounts in the manner provided hereun er in this deed to the Trust and nominees of all i stitu ions and organisations which make such contribution and all persons co-opted as Trustees by the Board of Trustees as provided hereinafter in clauses (a) to (f) of Article 6 of the Trust Deed are truetees of National Educational social Stust and their cate ories are sequented and recified in the above said article 6 (a) to (f) of the Trust Deed.

## ARTICLE 4 - OBJECT.

- (a) The object of the Trust shall be the promotion of education among the public add for that purpose to set up a publicschool and other allie institutions.
- (b) To establish and maintain institutions intended for the educational and cultural advancement of the public and their social welfare and physical well-being.
- (c) To actively participate and help in the implementation of the literary programme of the State.
- (d) To establish and maintain orphanages and old age homes in the State.
- (d) To organise and conduct human welfare activities.
- (f) To establish and maintain institutions providing job oriented training and self employment sctivities.
- (g) To promote the spirit of communa /religious harmony and national integrations among the people by organising and conducting programmes/activities to ards achieving the objectives.
- (h) This Trust will be a non profit making oneas envisaged in the provisions of the incometax Act 1961.
- (i) To manage endowments and grant scholarships or other assistance to meritorious or desering poor students to pursue their studies.
- j) To conduct coaching classes for those appearing for all India competitive examinations, such as I.A.S. I.P.S. I.F.S etc.
- (k) To conduct co-ching classes for entrance examinations for

- (1) To conduct coaching classes for examinations conducted by various Boards for Recruitment to banks, Railways, LIC and other services.
- (m) To conduct classes for students in fine arts, such as dance, music, etc (vocal or instrumental).
- (n) To conduct classes for personality development spoken Enginsh Management studies journalism etc.
- (o) To conduct classes for Sanskrit, Hindi, Arabic, Vedanta, Yoga and other spiritual pursuits.
- (p) To organise a nducted tours with educative value to places of National importance.
- (q) To adopt or take over any other trust or any society registered under the Societies Registration Act or under similar statutes with objects similar to that of this trust.
- (r) To establish, maintain add r n boarding houses and other like institutions for the students and those connected with the institution.
- (s) To accept donations, grants, presents and other offering from individuals, institutions and Sovernments and to deal with the same for the purpose of the Trust.
- (t) To purchase and aintamn vehicles necessary for carrying out the objects of the trust.
- (u) To engage in any other activity which will beconducive to the object of the trust.

ARTICLE 6- CONSTITUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUST ES.

There shall be the follo ing categories of trustees and the Board of Trustees shall be constituted from such categories of Trustees in the manner provided hereunder.

# (a) Trustees by authors.

The three authors of the trust above named are eligible to be Principal Hereditary trustees on contribution further sum required as provided in clause (b) of Article 6 of the Trust Deed and the are permanent members of the Execu ive Committee. These three members have been permanently exempted from the three years election.

In the event of death of any Trustce by Authors or in the event of vacating the place for any other reason, his nominee or legal heir shall succeed him and will automatically becomethe Trustee by Author without election and t is privilege shall continue to the Trustee of Authors from generation to generation till the existence of the Trust and the institutions.

The Trust-e by Authors shall have the following powers.

a. To take on lease, purchase or otherwise acquire and to sell and otherwise dispose of any property, movable orimmovable for the purpose of the Trust or the constitutent institutions belonging to or under the man gement of the Trust.

b. To take on rent, purchase or construct buildings for the purpose of the trust or institutions belonging to the Trust.

in Clause (a) above and every individual who donates a sum of not less than Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fift, thousand only) to the trust shall be Hereditary Trustees and each of such hereditary trustees shall also be in the Boarf of Trustees. In the event of death of any hereditary trustee or in the event of his recating the place in the Trust on any other reason unless a nominee to succeed him is duly registered in the office of the Trust by the hereditary trustee by filling an a plication attested by two witnesses one of whom a member of the Executive Committee of the Trust, hiseldest legal heir shall be entitled to fill up his vacency in the trust. Subject to Article 6 clause (h) below. (Nomination once made may be changed by the hereditary trust e at any time prior to his ce sing to be the trustee.

(c) Nominated/Institutional Trustees.

One representative of every institution or organisation having identical views of the trust that donate to the trust a sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) nominated by such organisation or institution was shall be a nominated trustee or institutional trustee for such period as is determined by such bodis and duly intimated to the Trust and sach of such nominated trustees will be represented in the Boar of Trustees.

(d) Honorary Trustees.

Any distinguished person or persons of pre eminant repute and outstanding career shosen by the Board of Trustees as honorary trustees for a period of three years and co-opted to the Board of trustees and such honorary trustees on the Board of Trustees shill not be more than two at a time as provided in Article 7(d)

(e) The tenure of office of the Board of Trustees shall be three years provided such Board of trustees will continue in Office tile duly elected Board assumes charge.

(f) No person shall be eligible to hold office of the trustee who is a minor insolvent a person of unroun mind a paid servant under the Trest or any of the institutions under the Trust, a person convicted for a criminal offence involving moral surfitu

or any person against whom disciplinary action is taken and unishment inflicted for serious allegation of corruption or misbehaviour in any other trust or society.

- (g) Notwithstanding the tenure of office of nominated or institutional trustees as above fixed they shall continue in office until their successors assume office unless objected to by the institution or organisation nominating them.
- h. Vacancies of Life Tr stees in Group B in the Board of trustees, arising from death, resignation or other causes may be filled the Board by inducting their successors or nominees elected by such life trustees Group B who as not disqualified as per clause f) of Article 6 above such trustees shall holdoffice only for the unexpired period of the Boards tenure.
- (i) The election of the regular presi ent, office bearers, the member of Board of tristees and Execuive committee shall be conducted as soon as the required quorum of the Board of Trustees is reached.
- (j) The Board of Trustees shall meet at least once ain every three months and the annual meeting of the Board of trustee be held within four months of the closing of the financial year to evaluate the work: \*\*Txxx\*\* of the trust and the institutions under the Trust and to consider and pass the audited accounts and report. The quorum for a meeting of the Board shall be 25% of the total number of members of the Board of Trustees or 20 members present whichever is less.
- (k) Annual general body of the Trust will meet once in a year within 4 months of the closing of the financial year. The Secretary will apprise the meeting the overall working and financial affairs of the Trust for the previous year.
- (1) To elect the specified categories of trusties to the Board of trustees a general body meeting of the members of the trust will be held once in every three years, at least two weeks prior to the date fixed for the last annual general meeting of the Boar of Trustees during its each tenure. The representatives of such categories like Life Trustees group A and Life Trustees group b shall be elected from each of such groups by the trustees of each of such respective groups. The President of the Board of Trustees and in his beence the Vice President will preside over such meetings. The quorum of the meeting is 25% of the trustees of each categories of Life Trustees Group A and Group B or 20 members of each group present whichever is less.

All ICLE 7 - Powers of the Board of Trust.

The Board of Trustees shall have the following powers.

- a. To manage , administe and control the Trust fund and properties and institutions belonging to the Trust or under its management.
- b. To shoose not more than two eminent persons as honorary trustees and to co-opt them as members of the Board of Trustees for a period of three years but such honorary trustees in the trust or in the Board of Trustees shall not be more than two at a time.
- c. To frame rules and regulations that are not repugnant to the provisions of this deed necessary for the proper and efficient administration of the Trust and the institutions under the Trust.

- d. To borrow such amounts from individuals or from the institutions on the security of the land, buildings and other assets of the Trust or otherwise for any of the objects of the Trust, subject to the proviso to clause (b) above.
- (e) To appoint on such terms and conditions as the Board prescribes from time to time officers, teahnical and professional hands etc as they deem necessary and expedient for the purpose of maintaining the instit tions under the Trust and to take appropriate disciplinary actions including termination of service.
- (f) To appoint auditoror auditors to audit the accounts of the Trust and of the institutions under the Trust and to fix his or her remuneration.
- (g) To admit as members of the trust in the respective categories those who contribute the specified amount under clauses (b) (c) (d) and (e) of Article 6 above.
- (h) To amend the Trust Deed rules and regulations by a resolution passed by two thirds majority of the members of the Board of Trusties present and voting in th meeting specially convened by the purpose. But any amendment to the Trust Deed Rules and Regulations will be made only with the prior approval of the Comrissioner of income Tax.

ARTICLES 8 4 Constitution and powers of Execu ive Committee.

The Executive committee shall have power:-

- (b) To fill up the vacancies in Executive committee, arising from death resignation or other causes but such action of the Executive committee shall be got atified by the Board of Trustees in their immediate next meeting.
  - (c) To appoint such employees and staff as may be necessary to carry on the day to day work and affairs of the trust and to fix their salary and emoluments and service conditions su ject to the service condition as per clause (g) of Article 7.
  - (d) To take disciplinary action against the employees or members of the staff including the power to suspend remove or dismiss that from service.
  - (e) To o en and operate in the name of the Trust or in the names of the Institutions thereunder account or accounts with such bank or banks as they consider proper and to pay or c use t pay to the credit of any such account any mone, forming part of the Trust Fund or to place such roney on deposit with any bank subject to the provisions of the income Tax Act 1961 (Regulating investments by Charitable bpdies).

- f. To man ge administer and control the Trust properties and the Institu i as under its management subject to the overall control of the Board of trustees.
- (g) In the event of the president, Vice President, Secretary, Joint Secretary or the Treasurer ceasing to function on account of feath, resignation, retirement or other cases, the Executive committee may elect one from among them to act in such vacancy until the Bland of Trustees elects a new incumbent.
- (h) The quorum for the meeting of the Execu ive committee shall be five.
- (i) Notwithstanding apything contained elsewhere in this deed, until the first executive committee comes into existence in accordance with the provisions of this article, the functions of the committee may be carried on by the authors of Trust referred to Article 6 (k)
  - ARTICLE 9 Powers and duties of the President, Vice president, Secretary, Join Secretary and Treasurer.
- a. The President if present shall preside over the meeting of the Executive committee, in the absence of the Presi ent Vice president shall exercise ad discharge the power and duties of the Presi ent.
- b. The Bank accounts of the Trust and all the institutions under the Trust shall be oxerxed opened at the join: names of the President Secretary and Treasurer and the same sall be o eratedjointly by any two of them.
- c. The Secretary subject to the control and super ision of the Executive committee may exercise and perform such powers and duties as the Executive committee may f om time to time determine and in general carry on the executive functions of the Trust under the Deed of Trust.
- d. The Secretary shall be the Manager of the Educational I stitutions under the Trust until o berwise decided by the Executive Committee and shall exercise such powers in this regard in accordance with the laws in force and that are conferred upon him by the Board of Trustees.
- e. The Secretary shall convene the meetings of the Trust the Poard of Trustees and or the Executive committee in consolitation with the president. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to make available the income and expenditure statement and a proforma balance sheet of every quarter and the annual in ome and expenditure statement and balance sheet of every year for scrutiny of the Bo roof Trustees or the Executive committee. The agenda for he meetings shall be fixed by the Secretary in consultation with president as the case may 1
- f. The Secretary shall place be ore the Annual General Meeting of the Trustees to be held within four months of the close of each accounting year the audited income and expenditure statement and balance sheet of the previous year with a report on the working of the Trust and a budget estimate for the succeeding year.
- g. The Secretary and in his absence the Joint Secretary sall represent the trust of Boar d of Trustees in all legal proceedings.
- h. All documents to be executed or taken by the Trust shall be executed or taken in the joint names of the president and the Secretary.

- i. The Joint Secretary shall assist the Secretary generally and perform such functions and exercise such powers as are delegated to him by the Executive Committee and shall in the absence of the Secretary by death, resignation or other cause, perform all the duties and functions of the Secretary till a new Secretary is elected and assumed charges.
- j. The Treasurer shall be responsible for maintaining proper accounts for the Trust Fund properties and institutions under the Trust and of all the transactions of the Trust whilech shall be audited every year. The account year of the trust shall close on the financial ear from 1st April to 31st March every year.


ARTICLE 10 - Termination.
